

VILLAGE OF BROWNSDALE

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING OUT LOT 65 IN THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 103, RANGE 17, EXCEPT THE N 11 $\frac{2}{3}$ RODS AND EXCEPT A PARCEL CIRCUMSCRIBED BY A LINE COMMENCING AT THE SE CORNER OF SAID OUT LOT 65, THENCE SOUTH 27 RODS, THENCE EAST 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ RODS, THENCE SOUTH 8 RODS, THENCE EAST 10 RODS TO POINT OF BEGINNING, TO THE VILLAGE OF BROWNSDALE.

WHEREAS there has been an annexation / petition presented to this Council signed by Marie S. Brown, Administratrix D.B.N., C.T.A. Estate of Melissa E. Brown, and by Hosmer A. Brown, both owners sought to be annexed of record of lands/described as follows:

Out Lot 65 in the Northeast one-quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast one-quarter (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T 103, R 17, (Village of Brownsdale), according to a plat thereof record on Book 2, of plats, Page 4 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Mower County except the following parcels:

- a. North eleven and two thirds (N 11 $\frac{2}{3}$) rods of said out lot 65
- b. Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Out Lot 65, thence North 35 rods, thence West 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ rods, thence South 27 rods, thence East 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ thence South 8 rods, thence East 10 rods to the point of beginning.

The Village Council of the Village of Brownsdale, County of Mower, State of Minnesota ~~and Mower County~~ Ordains.

1. That said petition is regular in all respects, that said lands, as described in the preamble to this ordinance and in the petition presented to the Council, is properly suited to be subjected to the government of the Village, that it is in the best interests of the Village and of the area described that such lands be so annexed to the Village of Brownsdale and that said lands are hereby annexed thereto.
2. That this ordinance shall be published by the Village Clerk in the official Village newspaper at least once and shall be filed in the office of the Clerk together with an affidavit of publication in his ordinance book within 20 days after publication.
3. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication.
