NO. 101

A CURFEW ORDINANCE

The Village Council of the Village of Brownsdale, Mower County, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen years to be or loiter upon any of the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement, entertainment, or refreshment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places of the Village of Brownsdale between the hours of 10:30 P. M. and 6:00 A.M. unless accompanied by and under the control of some person of lawful age and upon some errand by permission or direction of his or her parent or guardian or employer. Such minor person shall not then loiter on the way, nor make any undue noise to disturb the peace and quiet of the village.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person or persons having the legal care, custody or control of any child under 18 years of age to allow or permit any such child or ward to violate the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation operating or in charge of any place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment to permit any minor under the age of 18 years to enter or remain in such place during the hours prohibited by this ordinance; provided however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply when such minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person, having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 4. Any parent, guardian or other person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of Section 2 or Section 3 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or shall be confined in the County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

Section 5. Any minor person who violates any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to arrest by any police officer of the Village without process. Upon such arrest, the person arrested shall be taken and delivered into the custody of his or her parent, guardian, or employer. Upon a second arrest, such offender shall be taken before the Justice of Peace for trial, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Upon a third and every subsequent arrest, and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).

Section 6. This ordinance is urgent in character and is passed for the immediate preservation of public peace and safety, and shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication.
