ORDINANCE NO. 1963-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR
EITHER ON-SALE OR OFF-SALE

The Village Council of Brownsdale, Minnesota ordains:

SECTION I

No person under 21 years of age shall present himself or herself at the Municipal Liquor Store and falsely represent himself or herself to be over 21 years of age for the purpose of purchasing or acquiring intoxicating liquor, either "on-sale" or "off-sale".

SECTION II

The manager of the Municipal Liquor Store, Village of Brownsdale, Minnesota, is hereby authorized in all cases where it is deemed necessary to require persons desiring to purchase liquor either "on-sale" or "off-sale", to sign a card giving his or her name, date of birth and address including the city and state in which he or she resides.

SECTION III-PENALTY

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars
