ORDINANCE CHANGING COUNCIL SALARIES

Whereas, Minnesota Statutes 412.181 authorizes the Village Council to increase the salaries of the Mayor and Councilmen by ordinance subject to the right of the voters to petition for a referendum on the ordinance within a period of 30 days after publication of the ordinance;

AND WHEREAS, the council deems the present salary of the Mayor and Councilmen inadequate to compensate them for the work incident to these offices and to attract qualified candidates to run for such offices;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BROWNSDALE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 2, 1970, the salary of the Mayor is fixed at \$360.00 per year and the salary of each Councilman is fixed at \$240.00 per year.

SECTION 2. Subject to the referendum provisions of Minnesota Statutes Sec. 412.181, this ordinance is effective from and after its passage and publication.
