ORDINANCE NO. 1976-4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS DURING DAYTIME HOURS AFTER OR DURING A SNOWFALL WHICH NECESSITATES SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS AND USE OF STREET PARKING

The City Council of the City of Brownsdale, Minnesota, ordains:

Section I. Definitions. Any term used in the ordinance and defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 169.01 has the meaning given it by that section.

Section II. After or during a snowfall which necessitates snow removal operations, no person shall park any vehicle or permit it to stand on any street within the city limits of Brownsdale so as to obstruct the removal of snow from the streets during snow removal operations conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Section III. The prohibitions of Section II shall not apply on any street after it has become substantially clear of snow and ice from curb to curb.

Section IV. The presence of any vehicle on any street when standing or parked in violation of this ordinance is prima facie evidence that the registered owner of the vehicle committed or authorized the commission of the violation.

Section V. Any police officer may remove a vehicle from a street when the vehicle is left unattended and hinders snow removal operations. Such vehicle shall not be released until the fees for towing and storage are paid in addition to any fine imposed for violation of this ordinance.

Section VI. The City of Brownsdale, and any of its agents or employees, shall not be responsible for any damages sustained by a

~~which~~ which has been removed and held due to a violation of this ordinance.

Section VII. All ordinances or parts of ordinances presently in existence in the City of Brownsdale which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and shall be of no further force and effect.

Section VIII. Parking. No person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle or permit it to stand on any street so as to obstruct traffic or permit it to stand on any street for a period of over 48 hours.

Section IX. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00.

Section X. Savings Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause, and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section XI. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
