

ORDINANCE NO. 1981-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THE STATE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT BY REFERENCE TO INCLUDE RECENT AMENDMENTS AND DEFINING THE DEFENSE OF EXHIBITION DRIVING AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE

The Council of the City of Brownsdale do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE.

The regulatory provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1971, Ch. 169 as amended by laws 1973 and by Laws 1974, are hereby adopted as traffic ordinance regulating the use of highways streets and alleys within the City of Brownsdale and are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as completely as if set out here in full.

Section 2. No person shall operate any vehicle in such manner as to create or cause unnecessary engine noise, tire squeal, skid or slide upon accelerating or stopping, or in any such manner as to simulate a temporary race or as to cause such vehicle to unnecessarily sway or turn abruptly.

Section 3. PENALTY. Any violation of the statutes adopted by reference in section 1 or of the ordinance referred to in section 2, is a violation of this ordinance when it occurs within the City of Brownsdale. Any person thus violating any provision to this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00 or by confinement in the City or county jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or both, except for offenses defined to be a petty misdemeanor shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, but if a minimum fine or imprisonment is prescribed by the state highway traffic act for an offense, such penalty shall apply to persons convicted of the same offense under this ordinance.
