ORDINANCE NO. 1984-1

POLICY FOR ALLEGATIONS OF POLICE MISCONDUCT.

The City Council of the City of Brownsdale Minnesota, ordains. All Allegations of Police misconduct by any person, private citizen or other, are to be handle as follows:

1. All allegations are to be written and signed by the complaining party(s).
2. All written complaints will be received by the Mayor of this city within a reasonable amount of time.
3. All complaints will contain the name of the officer, the date and approximated time of the alleged incident, and a complete description of the incident. Also names of any other witnesses to the incident.

The Mayor will then be responsible for investigating all complaints as to their validity. This includes but is not limited to receiving written statements from the officer involved and any witnesses.

In case the complaint is against a partime officer of this department, the mayor will notify the Police Chief.

The Mayor will then present any and all findings to the City Council for appropriate action.
